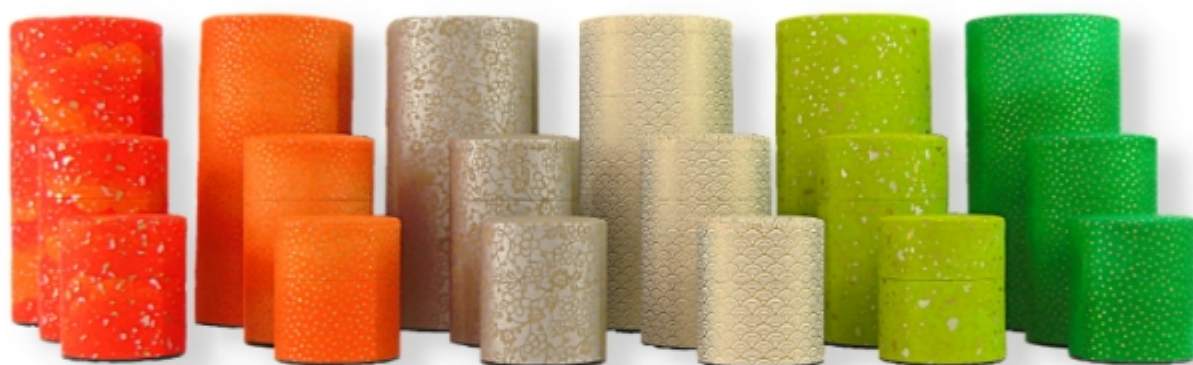

The main body is made from a single sheet of steel and electrically welded at the seam. We concern for our environment, our company uses only lead-free paint and solders.



'KOTODO' +
MADE IN JAPAN
is embossed on the
bottom of each canister.



With user safety in mind, we designed the lid and body of our canisters with beveled edges.

In order to make sure the lid and body are tightly secured, a small notch inside the lid is fitted to the body. When twisting to close, the lid snaps into place with an audible click to indicate the perfect, secure alignment of both pieces. Thanks to our superior craftsmanship, our handmade canisters have a smooth outer surface where the lid and body meet that is aesthetically pleasing and minimizes friction thereby prolonging the life of the washi paper.



KOTODO Washi tea tin canisters come in over 100 unique, hand-wrapped designs. The washi used is traditional Japanese paper made from the bark of small trees native to Japan. This paper has a soft, warm texture that creates a sense of comfort. Each sheet of washi is hand-dyed by skilled artisans in Kyoto, using wooden plates to carefully reproduce the colors and patterns, one by one. Since these Japanese Yu-zen washi papers are crafted by hand, slight variations in color and texture may occur. We hope you enjoy the beauty and uniqueness of our Yu-zen washi, individually hand-dyed in Kyoto, Japan.
